SECTION 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

▲ RULE 1 - REGULATIONS GOVERNING SHIPMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES:

Vehicles shipped at the rates contained herein will be governed by the regulations contained in Rule 2, Page 3 of Woods Hole, Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket Steamship Authority's Local Freight Tariff of Class and Commodity Rates, MDPU No. F-104, supplements thereto or reissues thereof.

RULE 2 - RESERVATIONS AND REDEMPTIONS:

- a) Requests for reservation of space for vehicles will be made year round upon applications and prepayment of transportation charges (at least equal to that applicable to passenger automobiles) to the Reservation Bureau. If space is not used - refund of fares paid will be governed by Rule 2(b) below. At customer's option - passenger fares may also be prepaid.
- b) A refund of the purchase price will be issued if cancellation notice is received by the Authority at least 14 days in advance of scheduled departure time. Otherwise, the ticket may only be used for another date when at least 1 hour notice is received.
- c) A reservation changed within 14 days of scheduled departure and subsequently cancelled at any time will be subject to the applicable refund penalty. Changes will require a minimum of 1 hour notice prior to the scheduled sailing trip.
- d) There is a \$10.00 processing charge for all refunds regardless of when cancellation notice is received or for the replacement of vehicle ticket.
- ▲ e) Refund of passenger fare will be made under provisions of Rule 2, Page 5 of MDPU No. P-81, supplements thereto or reissues thereof.
- f) In the event that a reservation is not changed with at least 1 hour advance notice or used as reserved, the ticket shall be valid for stand-by travel solely on the date last reserved. This vehicle shall have no priority over other stand-by vehicles.

SECTION 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (Continued)

RULE 3 - AUTOMOBILES AND LIVESTOCK VEHICLES ORIGINATING FROM EITHER
MARTHA'S VINEYARD OR NANTUCKET SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR EXCURSION
FARES SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- a) Residency affidavit, including a listing on an island town published street list, must be completed and submitted to the Steamship Authority. Upon acceptance, a profile number will be issued which must be referred to at time of ticket purchase.
- b) The vehicle traveling at excursion fare must be so rated prior to commencement of travel.
- c) Transportation will be restricted to vehicle whose registration number appears on ticket.
- d) Ticket segment for transportation to the island will only be valid if ticket segment for transportation originating from the island has been used.
- e) S/S Authority approved company charge accounts are not eligible for excursion fares.
- f) Island residents in active military service or a full time college student will be eligible to travel on an excursion fare on a one-way basis regardless of the point of origin or date of return, provided that an active service card for the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps or Coast Guard or documentation from college registrar's office is shown.
- g) Individuals in active military service who are stationed on Martha's Vineyard or Nantucket will be eligible to travel on an excursion fare even though their vehicle and driver's licenses do not show them as being island residents, provided that an active service card is shown. These individuals are also eligible for Rule 3 (f) above.

RULE 4 - SECURITY NOTICE:

All customers and passengers, their vehicles, possessions, and cargo are subject to search and inspection at the discretion of the Steamship Authority.

Passengers and persons who refuse to submit to search and inspection will not be allowed to board.

The master of the vessel has the right to seize any item deemed as dangerous and detain any person possessing such item pending the arrival of law enforcement authorities.

SECTION II - GROUP ROUND TRIP RATES FOR PASSENGER AUTOMOBILES

▲ GROUP ROUND TRIP PASSENGER AUTOMOBILES:

Applies to automobiles, pick-ups and panel vans moving in conjunction with passenger groups as defined in Steamship Authority Tariff MDPU NO. P-81, supplements thereto or reissues thereof. The number of cars transported at the reduced group automobile rates, will be limited to not more than one car for each five (5) persons in the passenger group. Group round trip automobile must travel as a group from point of origin to destination and return, except when scheduled by the S/S Authority's Group Sales Office to travel independently. Rates do not include driver or passengers.
